CCR&R offers a variety of online workshops that you can do "on demand", 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The **first 10 hours are provided free of charge** to individuals who work at programs listed in the CCR&R database or for individual pursuing a family child care license.

1. Go to the E-Academy page on CCR&R website to access an up to date listing of online workshops.
2. Decide which workshops you want to take - write down the *name* and *course number*.
3. **Register online using the Registration Form link located on both CCR&R's home page and on the E-Academy page.**
4. Complete the form and just click "submit" - your registration request will be sent directly to CCR&R. It can take up to 48 hours for you to receive a confirmation and further instructions.

Online workshops are available to you 24 hours per day, seven days a week. You can take them at home and at work.

You will need an internet connection, a good operating computer, and printer. Certificates for online workshops can be printed upon completion of the training. These trainings will automatically appear on your professional development record.
